

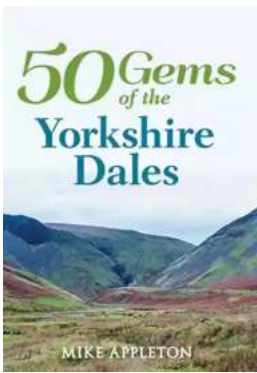

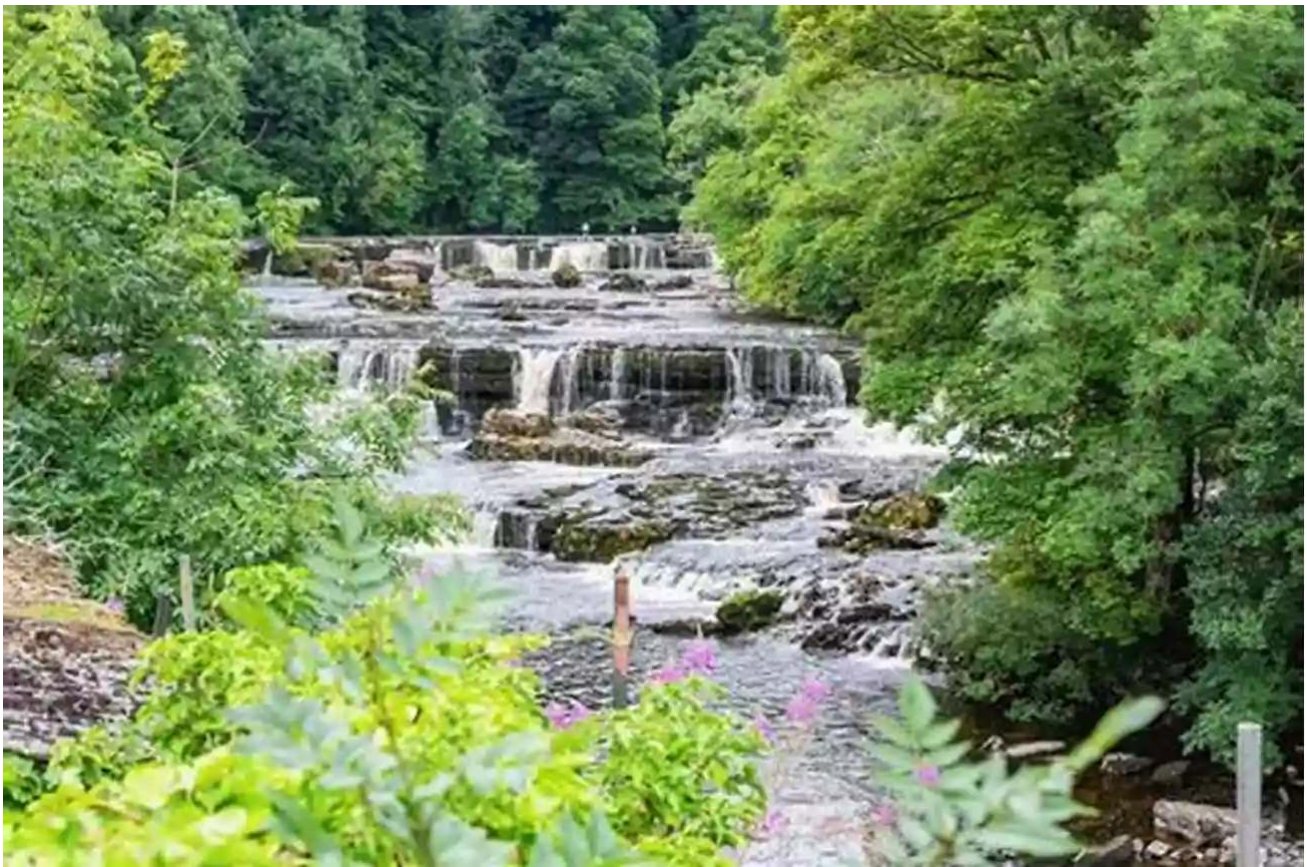

2. Aysgarth Falls

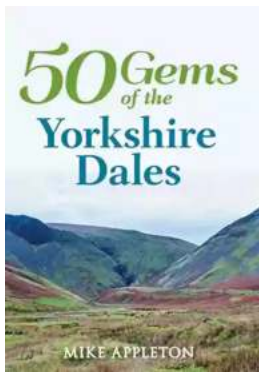
