Antibiotic resistant strains of bacteria have evolved as a result of pumping livestock with antibiotics, endangering the public.

Each day, a vegan saves approximately 1,100 gallons of water, 45 pounds of grain, 30 square feet of forested land, 20 pounds of CO2 equivalent, and one animal's life.

Animal agriculture is the leading cause of deforestation and species extinction. It is responsible for 70% of Amazon destruction, as trees are cleared to raise livestock and grow feed crops.

Approximately 2,800 gallons of water are needed to produce 1 pound of beef, requiring 10 hamburgers is the equivalent of not powering a city for a year. A vegan salad roughly half the amount of water than the average meat-eater.

70% of the grain grown in the United States is fed to livestock. We could feed more than 11 times the number of people if we were to consume grains directly.

Currently, 54% of the world's fisheries are over-exploited or depleted, and we could see fisheries collapse by 2048. For every 1 pound of fish caught, 3 pounds of unintended bycatch (dolphins, sea turtles, etc.) is caught and discarded. Animal agriculture is also the leading cause of ocean dead-zones.

Every minute, 7 million pounds of excrement are produced by farm animals in the U.S. A farm with 2,500 dairy cows produces as much waste as a city of 41,000 people. Unlike human waste, it is untreated. Some is sprayed on crops as fertilizer, but the excrement is collected in giant open lagoons, a major nuisance for those who live nearby.

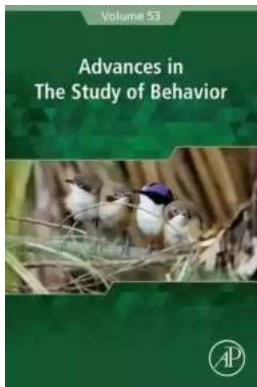
