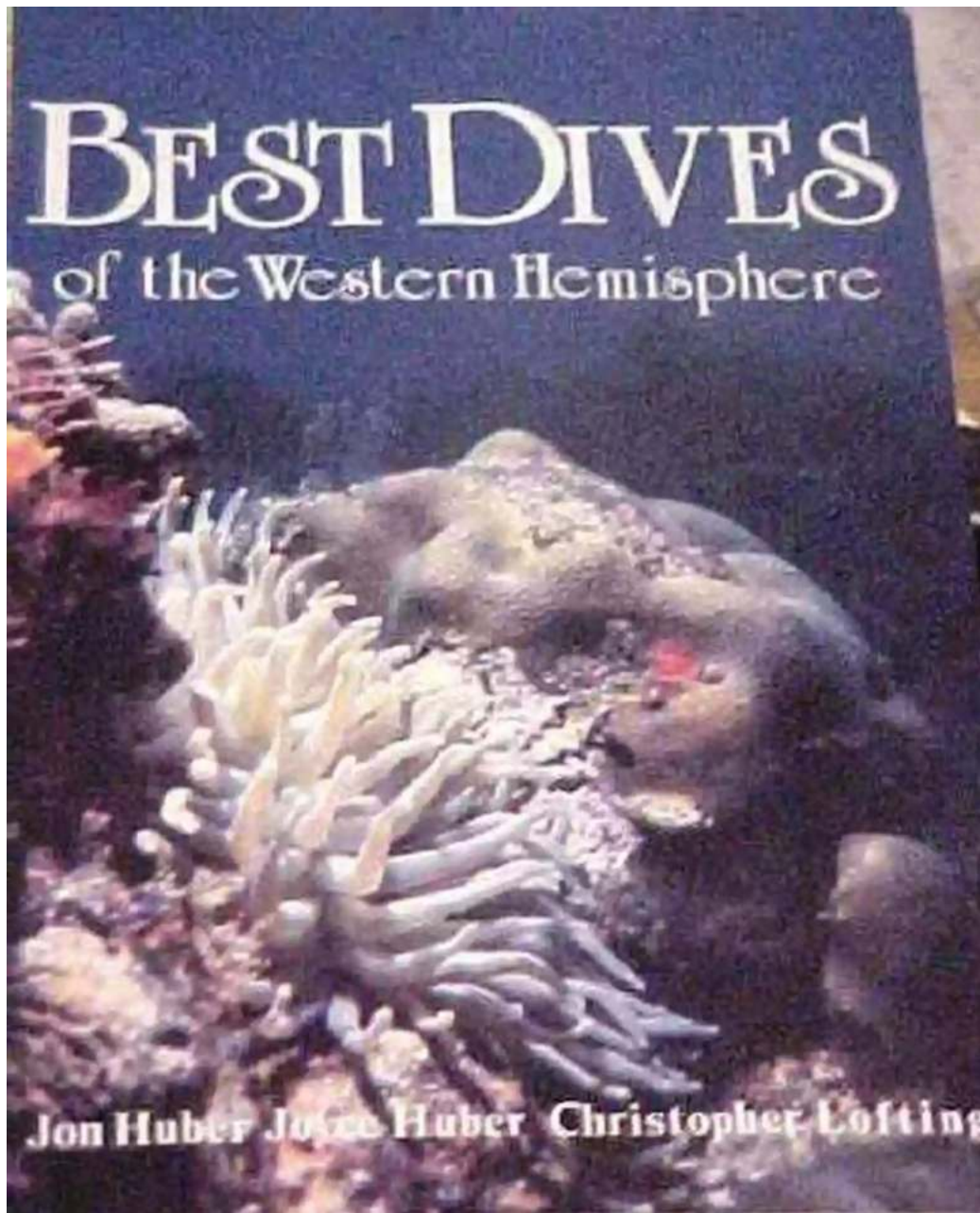


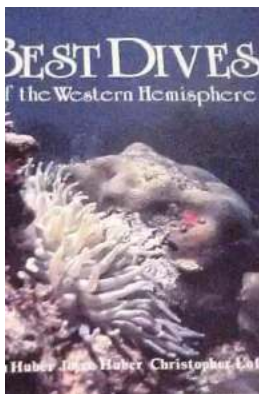

## The Great Blue Hole, Belize



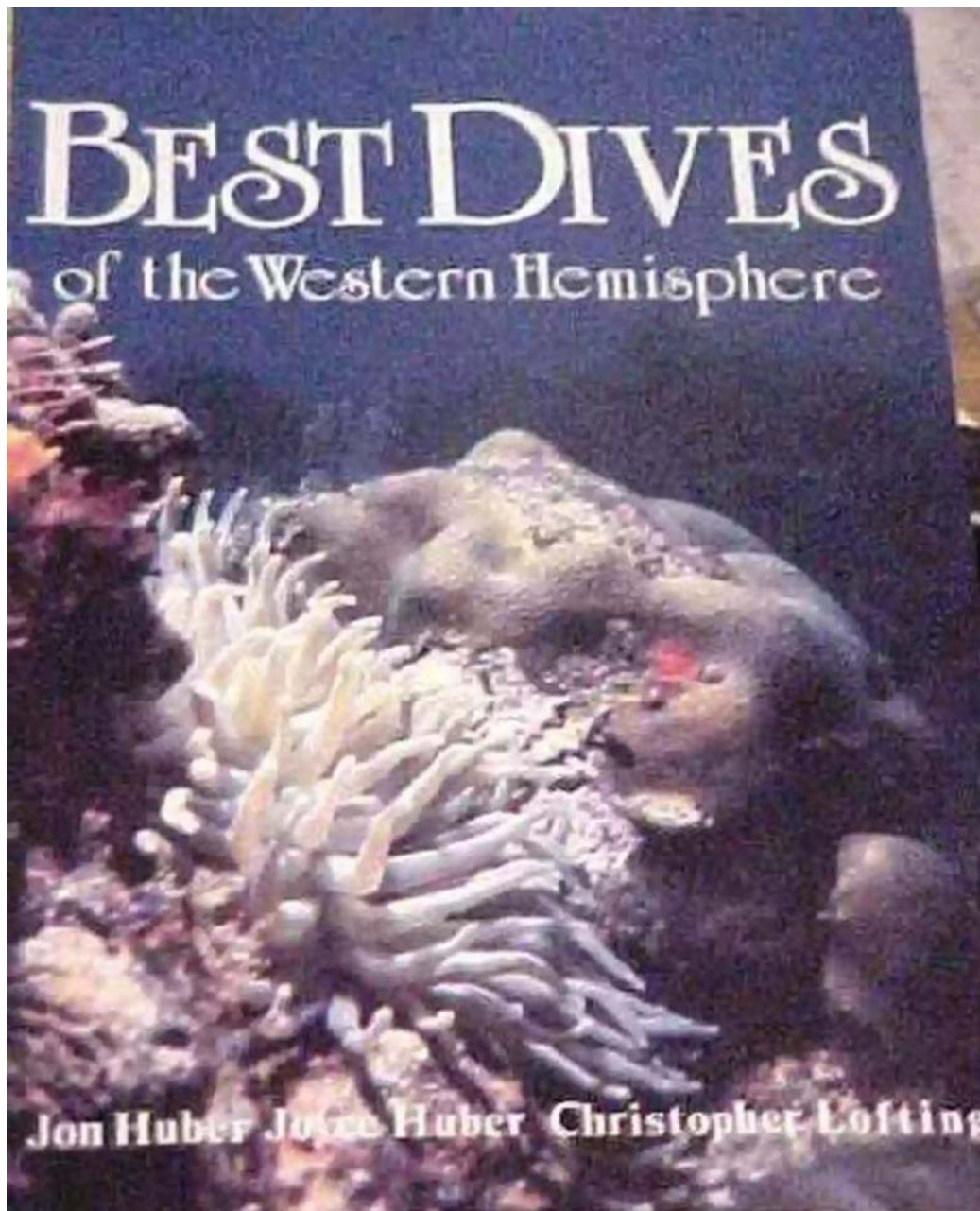
