MATERIALS AND TOOLS:

Original yarn: Kid's cotton (100% mercerized cotton, 330m/361 yds per 100 g skein)

Alternative yarn: Fingering 4 ply/ 14 wpi

Hook: 2.00 mm

Supplies: needle or thin hook for thread ends, knitting markers, scissors, ruler or tape measure, textile glue.

ABBREVIATIONS: all stitches are listed in US terms!

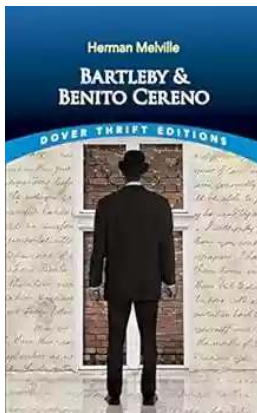
To work this pattern you need to know how to make a chain, slip stitch, single crochet, single crochet back loop only, half double crochet, double crochet, increase, decrease and how to read an abbreviated crochet pattern.

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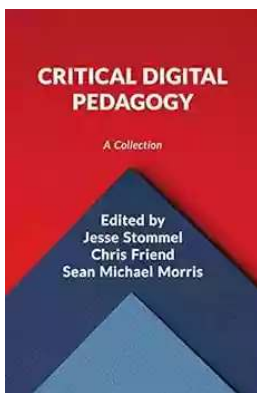
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
