

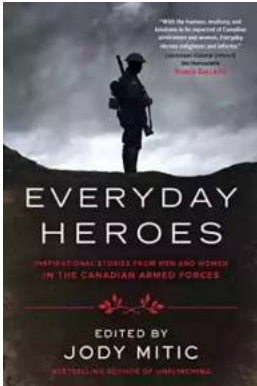

## 2. Corporal Robert Semrau: Acts of Compassion



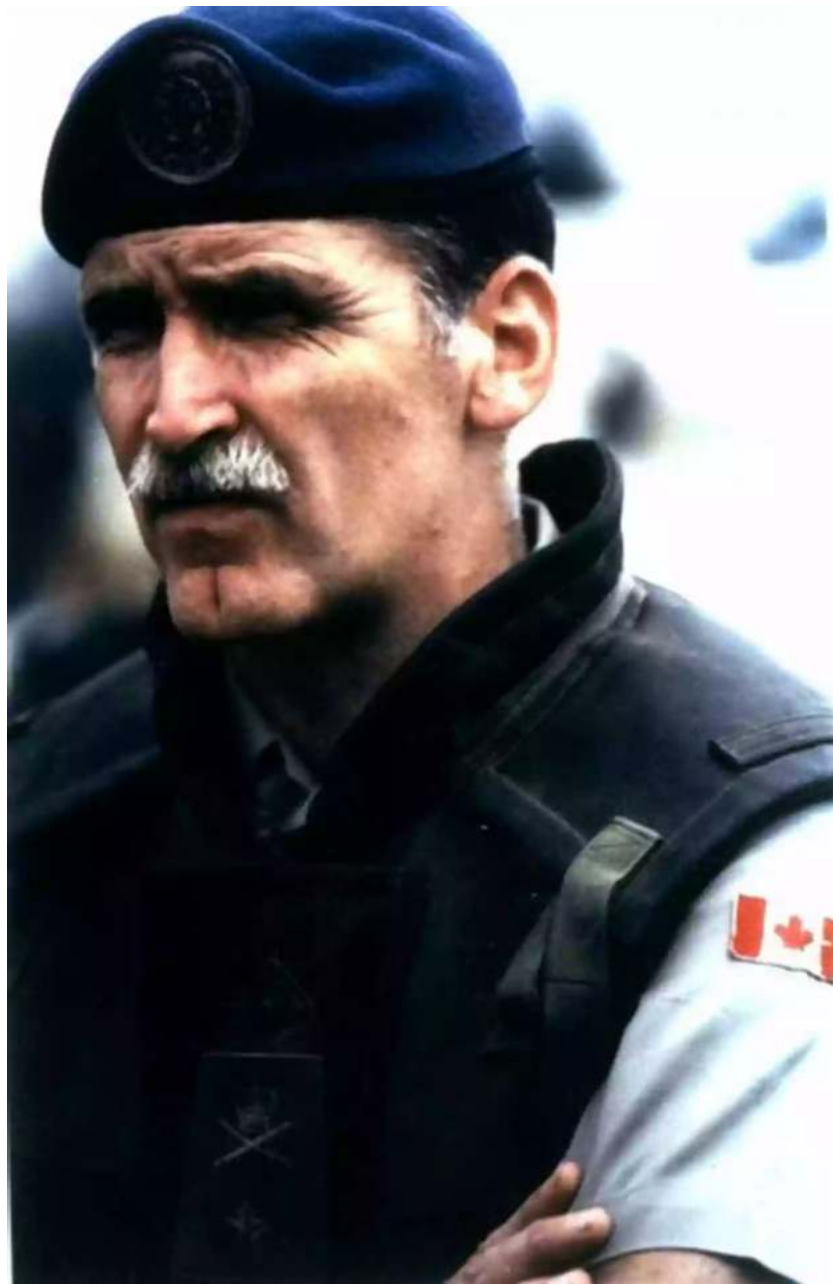
