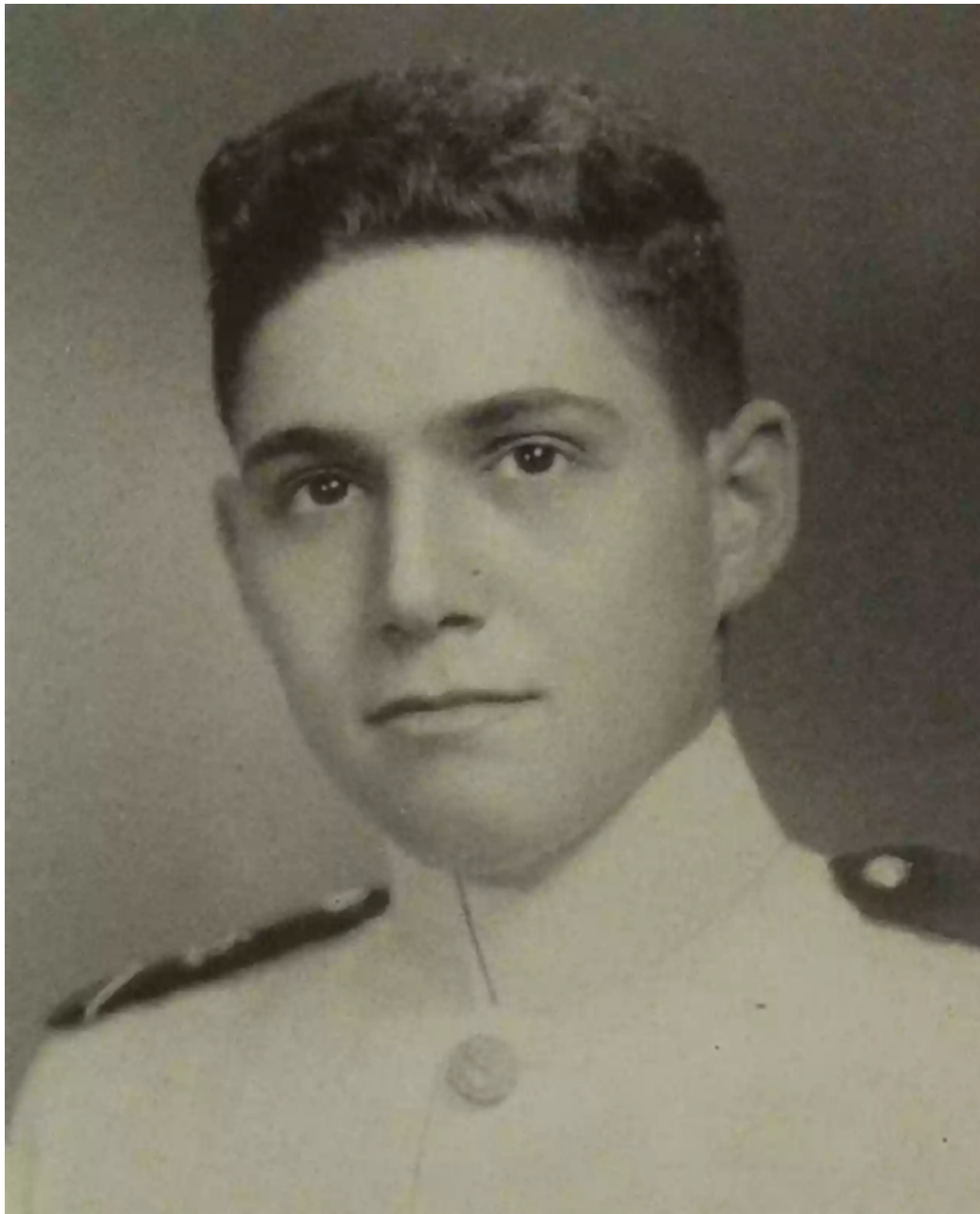


2. Private Hector A. Cafferata Jr.

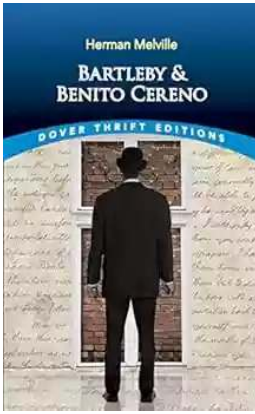

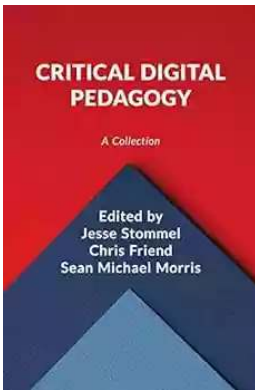
