

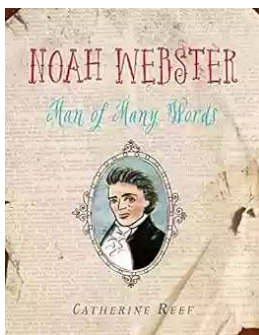
# Noah Webster: Man of Many Words

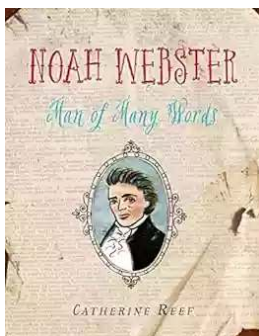
