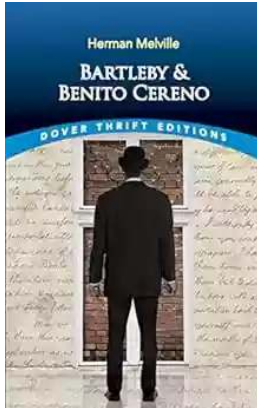

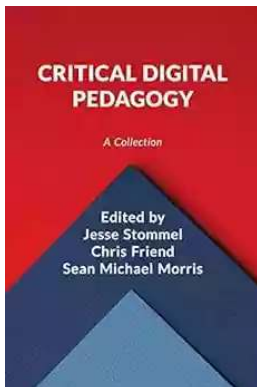
Internationally, there are too many variations to enable an all-embracing book to
