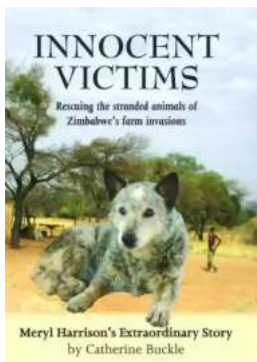


Rescuing The Stranded Animals Of Zimbabwe Farm Invasions

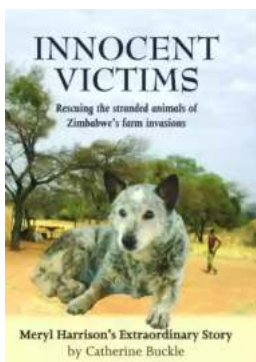
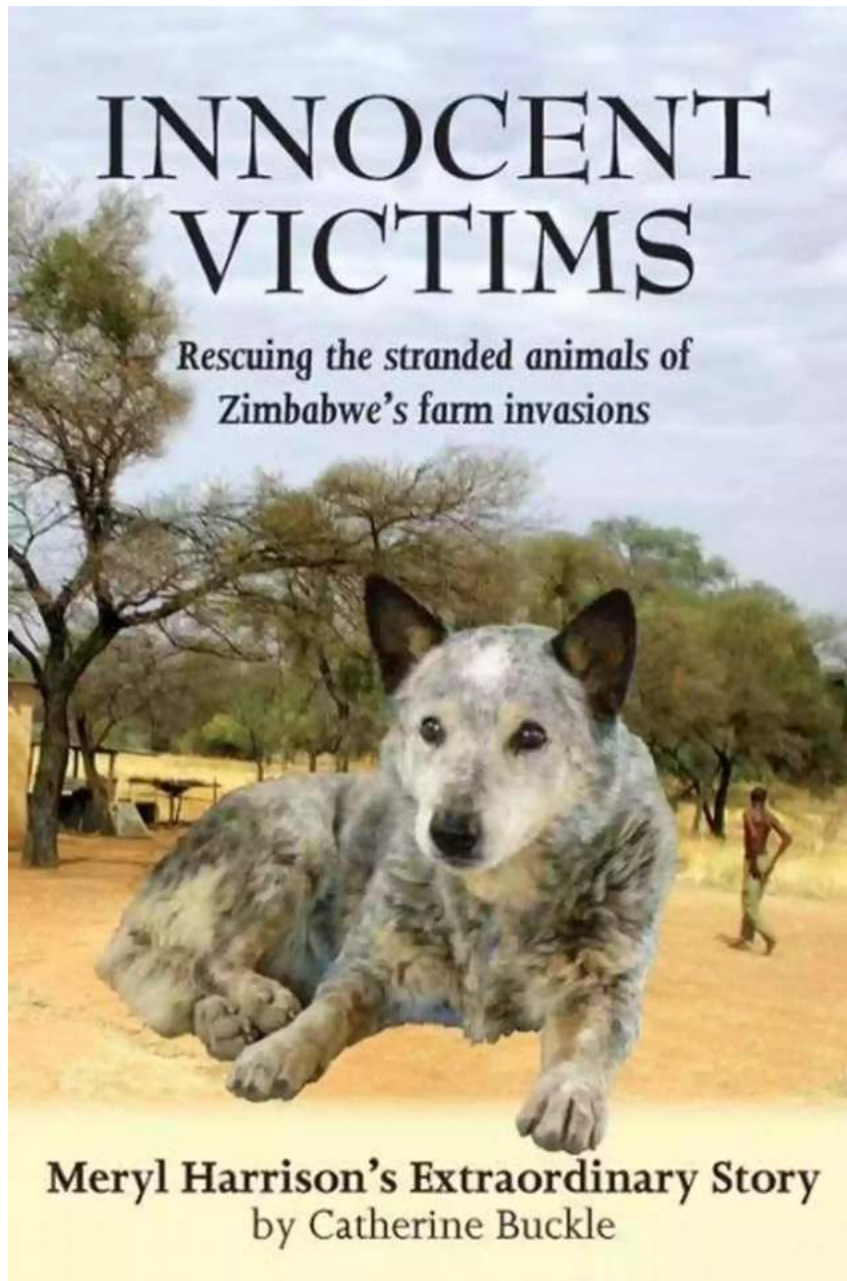
