

- Knitting needles Size 6 (4mm)
- Wool yarn A medium weight yarn in your preferred color
- Stuffing Polyester fiberfill or cotton filling
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

Step 1: Casting On

Start by casting on 10 stitches using your knitting needles and the long tail caston method. Leave a long tail, approximately twice the length of your finished dog's body.




Step 2: Knitting the Body

Row 1: Knit all stitches.

Row 2: Purl all stitches.

Thread the tail of the yarn through a yarn needle. Pass the needle through the remaining stitches of the head, remove them from the knitting needle, and pull tight to close the opening. Secure the yarn by weaving it through the fabric.




Step 5: Knitting the Legs and Ears

For the legs and ears, we will knit small rectangles and fold them to create the desired shape.

Legs: Cast on 4 stitches and knit every row until you have the desired length for the legs. Bind off the stitches and repeat for the second leg.

Ears: Cast on 2 stitches and knit every row until you have the desired length for the ears. Bind off the stitches and repeat for the second ear.
