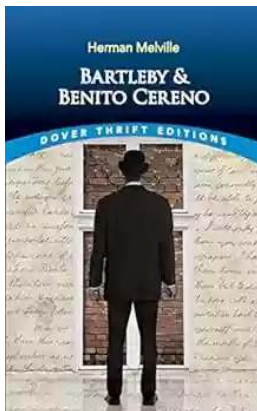

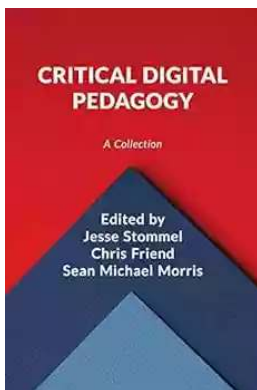
task. With quiet determination, he overcame one hurdle after another and achieved the captaincy of Team India in all three formats of the game.

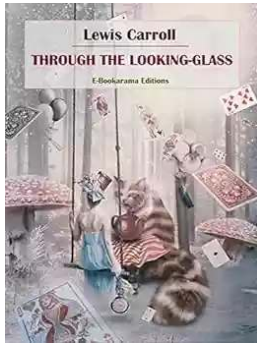
