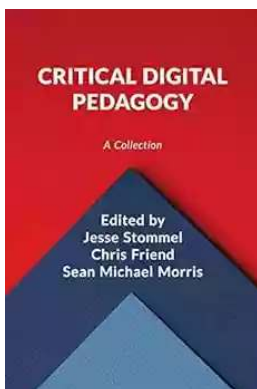
these support services.
