

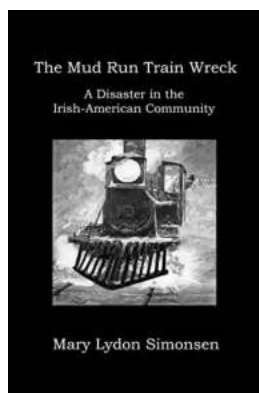

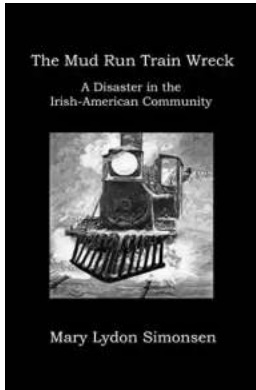

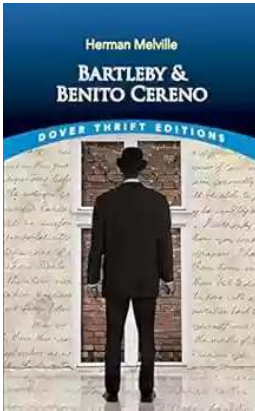


On October 10, 1888, the worst train disaster in the history of Pennsylvania took place at the Mud Run railway station. The victims were excursionists who had traveled from Scranton to Hazleton to celebrate the birth of Father Mathew Theobald, the Irish Apostle of Temperance, with a parade and picnic arranged by the Catholic Total Abstinence Union.

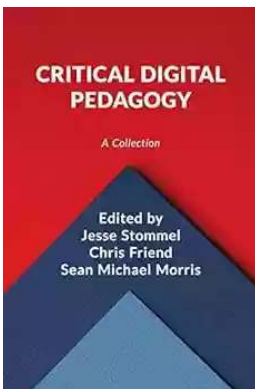

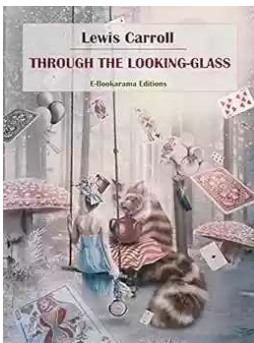
